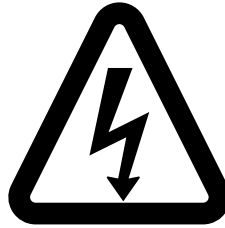

Cleaning - OEM Module

Cleaning the product is generally not required although in some instances it may be necessary if excess dust/hair has accumulated on the OEM module during operation or storage.

To clean the OEM module please follow the following precautions:

- Ensure that the OEM module is not connected to any power source at all.
- Ensure the OEM module is handled by its edges at all times to avoid damage to electronic components and use precautions against static discharge onto the module.
- Remove the OEM module from the target system.
- Remove all cables and external connections to the OEM module.
- Place the OEM module on an antistatic surface.
- Use a soft-bristled antistatic brush to gently brush away any dust or hair or alternatively, use an air blower to displace any dust as necessary.
- Once cleaning has been completed, reassemble the OEM module back into its target system observing static precautions.
- Reconnect power and cabling as required.

Cleaning - System Product

Cleaning a system product is not advised although in some instances it may be necessary if excess dirt/dust/hair has accumulated onto the product or if minor liquid spillages have occurred onto the product.

In order to determine whether the system product can be cleaned, the dirt/spillage should **not** be:



- Near, inside or over an opening within the product enclosure.
- Inside or over an external connector on the product including the power cord connector.

If there is a spillage over a ventilation slot, external data/power connector or product aperture, please remove power from the unit without contacting the liquid and contact Cambrionix immediately.

If the dirt/spillage is in a cleanable position then please follow the following guidelines for cleaning:

- Ensure that the product is switched off and the power cord is removed from the product. Hold the power cable by the plug and do not touch either the plug or the power cord with wet or damp hands as an electrical shock may result.
- Wipe the product with a clean, dry and soft cloth. Do not use detergents which contain alcohol, solvent or surface-active agents. Do not spray water or detergent directly onto the product.
- Wet a soft and dry cloth in water and wring thoroughly to clean the product as required.
- Dry the product thoroughly once the cleaning has finished.
- Reconnect the power cord and use your product as advised once cleaning and drying is complete.
